

## **X-TREME OFFROADERS**

May 18, 2008 Monthly Meeting

The Meeting was called to order at 5:10pm.

Roll Call:

They will report back at the June Meeting. Cheryl also agreed to contact Dave Romero regarding his progress with

MC Body Shop on the tow truck for Rock crawl. Everyone was again reminded of Creek and Trail. Virgil confirmed that he would have the advertising and sponsor posters prepared for distribution by mid-June.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Zach Skinners' membership in the club was voted on and approved unanimously. His Club dues for the remainder of the year are \$12.00. Zach is presently out of town, however, Cheryl will notify him via email and cell phone of the voting results and his fees that are due. The membership in 4Wheeldrive Hardware was discussed and it was unanimously agreed for Xtreme Offroaders to join this program. Some members already order from this company and had very good feedback for them. Fred made a motion to approve the membership application and Toni 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Toni suggested a run to Crater Lake possibly on the third weekend in August, this will be discussed again at the July or August meeting. Virgil said that he has a jeep tub for sale and wanted to invite all male club members to a Bachelor Party for Scott Adams to be held on May 31, 2008 at Virgil's house.

Junes' meeting will be held at the Rock Crawl grounds in order to discuss course changes and do additional clean up if necessary. The meeting will be on June 8, 2008 at 10:00am.
